

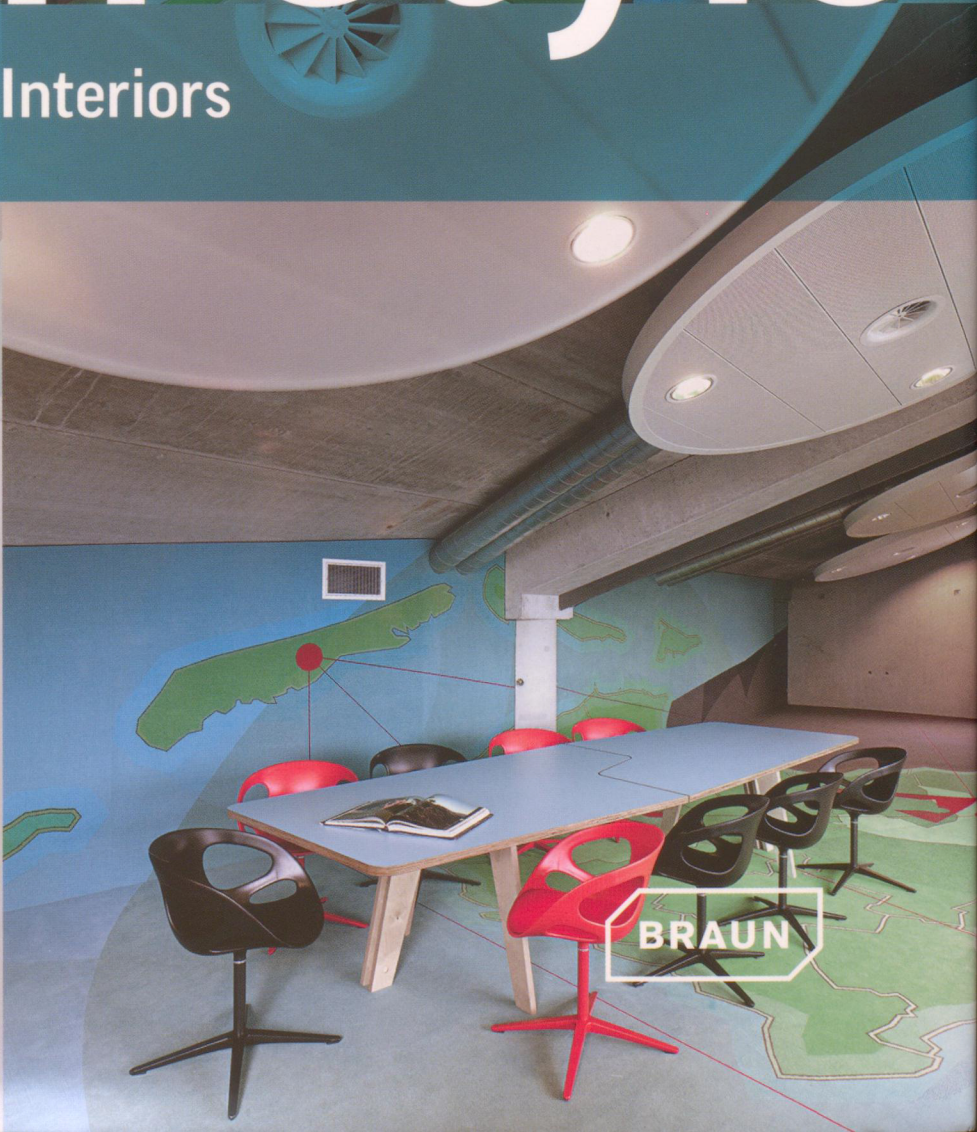

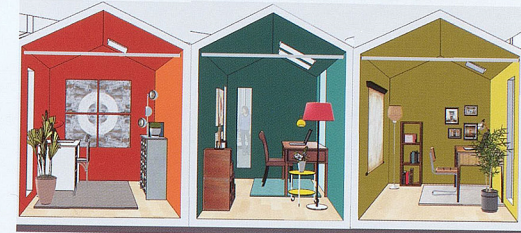




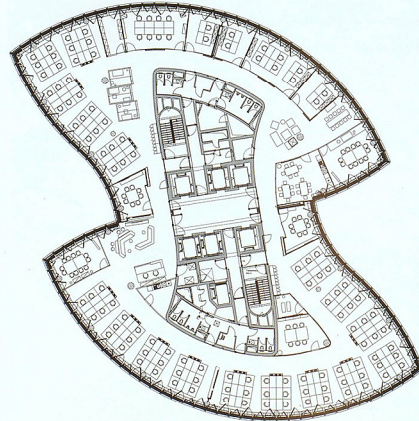
TRIVAGO SKY OFFICE

This project involved the extension of the trivago offices in the Sky Office building in Düsseldorf to accommodate 300 additional employees. The 3,200-square-meter office space is spread over three floors and the fifteenth floor offers spectacular views over the city of Düsseldorf and the Rhine. The wings of the building alternate between open space areas that house the work stations, and closed areas accommodating the conference and meeting rooms, lounges, sports facilities, kitchen and team areas. These more private areas also feature quiet zones such as the think tanks. The design concept is inspired by the idea of a city as a living and dynamic space with all its variety and contrasts.







Creating an atmosphere that promotes openness and lightheartedness, this design inspires creativity and encourages employees to think outside the box. The variety and diversity of the office spaces is as varied as the cultural identities of the employees.
